Subject: Moodus Reservoir Drawdown

Dave,

As we discussed last week, the CT DEEP is still reviewing the possible drawdown of the Moodus Reservoir this winter. That being said, if a property owner wishes to do work around the shoreline, it will require permitting from the East Haddam Inlands Wetlands and Watercourses Commission (IWWC). The Commission is required to have the application on the agenda twice and they meet monthly. The permit is valid for five years so if the drawdown occurs next year, the applicants don't have to reapply. I have attached the IWWC application and some typical drawing for shoreline stabilizing using natural materials. The second email will have shoreline stabilization techniques and methods of incorporation native plantings to assist in shoreline protection.
